Visibility from 151st will be hindered.

Member Locacius suggested that people should walk by all the food vendors when they arrive. Beer Tent will need to be near the stage.

Commissioner De Vivo will place cones on the park property to show the proposed layout so committee members can walk through the site and see how

the layout works. Member Robinson recommended using temporary power the first year. Questions to address: Where to put the carnival? Where to put the food vendors?

10. Next Meeting


Next meeting will be February 20, 2018, at 5:00 p.m.
