Help the Village of Homer Glen Beat 2012's Collection of Over 75,000 lbs of Recyclables

Looking to Spring Clean your home? Don't delay, on Saturday, March 23rd from 9a.m. to 1p.m., Homer Glen residents can drop off unwanted papers and electronics at the Village's spring recycling event located at the Hadley Middle School parking lot (15731 S Bell Rd). Village Manager Cameron Davis commented that "It's the perfect time to get your homes organized by safely and responsibly disposing of confidential documents and surplus electronics." Cintas document shredding experts will securely shred, on site, a maximum of 10 boxes/bags of paper per resident. Vintage Tech employees will also be available to unload unwanted electronics.

"I can't believe that last year's four hour recycling event resulted in the collection of over 44,000 lbs of shredded paper and over 31,000 lbs of electronics," Mayor Jim Daley stated. "I encourage all Homer Glen residents to take advantage of this free event," Mayor Daley continued. "I know that on March 23rd we will crush last year's outstanding totals and create a new record amount of recyclables kept out of Illinois landfills," concluded Mayor Daley.
