Seeking Nominees for the Community and Nature in Harmony Award

Nominees for the *2013 Community and Nature in Harmony Awards* are currently being sought to recognize an individual or group who, through the preservation, restoration, and/or beautification of land within the Village of Homer Glen or unincorporated Homer Township, has demonstrated commitment to the environment and in the process significantly contributed to community pride. The *Community and Nature in Harmony Award* was originally created in 2002 to celebrate Homer Glen Lands Day, which is observed annually in conjunction with National Public Lands Day in September.

This is the 12th year for the award program, which has honored more than 200 individuals, businesses, and organizations. Selections for recipients of the award are based on nominations from the public for those people who have contributed significantly to environmental efforts. The *Community and Nature in Harmony Award* program has received many positive comments since it was first initiated. There are many more people in the Homer Glen community who demonstrate a commitment to the environment, and we would like to recognize these efforts by offering the award again in 2013. Awards will be presented in September in conjunction with Homer Glen Lands Day. The deadline for nominations is August 1, 2013.
