## Village of Homer Glen's Annual Road Resurfacing Program Beginning in August

The Village's annual roadway resurfacing program will begin in August. Funded by the Village's General and Motor Fuel Tax funds, Homer Glen's roadway resurfacing program is designed to provide the community with safe roads. Each year, roads within the community are evaluated to determine which need preventative maintenance such as patching, crack-filling or complete surface replacement. This year's program will also include the widening and repaving of Parker Road, between 143<sup>rd</sup> and 151<sup>st</sup> Streets, in preparation for the major construction projects planned for 143<sup>rd</sup> and 159<sup>th</sup> Streets.

Village of Homer Glen's Mayor Jim Daley stated "Improved roadway conditions will benefit residents and businesses, maintaining property values for residents and allowing businesses easier travel for the delivery of goods and services." "In Homer Glen, our strong transportation system is carefully monitored and maintained by the Homer Township Roadway District's dedicated workforce" concluded the Mayor. Mayor Daley would also like to remind motorists to stay alert, use caution and abide by all traffic regulations when driving through construction zones.
