Will County Sheriff's Office to Use State Grant Money to Perform Seat Belt Checks in Homer Glen

During the month of March, the Will County Sheriff's Office will continue their efforts to make sure seat belts are used by drivers in the Village of Homer Glen. On March 14th (143rd St. between Parker & Will Cook Rd.) and March 21st, (159th St. corridor) during the evening hours, Sheriff patrols will ticket those seatbelt-less drivers within the Village. In accordance with the new State Law passed on January 1st of this year, the Sheriff's Office will also ticket those non-compliant passengers in the back seat. "Everyone traveling in a motor vehicle should wear a seat belt at all times," stated Mayor Jim Daley, Village of Homer Glen. "Seat belts save lives!" concluded Mayor Daley.
