## Village of Homer Glen's Package Liquor License Holders

### Do Not Sell Liquor to Minors

**Homer Glen, (May 10, 2012)**

On Monday, May 7, 2012, an underage volunteer accompanied an undercover Will County Sheriff's Deputy in unscheduled visits to determine if Homer Glen package liquor licensed businesses would sell liquor to a minor. The undercover operation resulted in 100% compliance from all eleven Homer Glen package liquor businesses. Mayor James Daley commented, "I'm proud that our liquor license holders did not sell liquor to minors and are cooperating with the Village in working to curtail underage drinking." The Village and Sheriff's Department also commend the liquor license establishments for their diligence in checking id's prior to selling packaged liquor. The Sheriff's office has noted that this is the first of several undercover operations which will take place throughout the year. "I'm confident that the remaining liquor license holders will also abide by the Village ordinances and State laws," stated Mayor Daley. "Together we can ensure the safety of our children and the overall well-being of the community," the Mayor concluded.
