



## Village Hall Park Now Open!

## Woodbine Area Regional Drainage Improvement Project

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The Village is continuing to work with the engineering firm HR Green on the completion of the Woodbine Area Regional Drainage Improvement Project plan and recommendations.

A critical part of this improvement project is the resident questionnaire. The questionnaire's results will be utilized by the Village to gain information and feedback from residents, who live in this area, about their storm water concerns and suggestions. This questionnaire was sent to over 400 residents in the Woodbine area. To date, the Village has received nearly 33% of the completed questionnaires. The Board and I want to thank the residents for their participation and cooperation with this very important community improvement project.
