**RE: Ditch Grading Work
 S Buckberry Lane**

Dear Mike,

We at GLI are pleased to provide you with this proposal for the work you had requested. Please be advised that all the spoils from this project site have to be transported to an approved CCDD dump site. If after review you should have any questions please feel free to give me a call. Following is the work to be completed within this proposal.

Option 1 Provide all equipment and labor to complete the following work. Mobilize excavator machine with a ditching bucket to grade and clean the length of the ditch from the culvert at 184th Street down to the culvert that crosses S Buckberry Lane. Care will be taken not to disturb the areas that approach the wet lands. While the ditch grading is taking place the grades will be measured with a lazer level to insure that proper pitch is scored to get the water to run the length of the ditch. GLI has figured to excavate and haul off approx. 60 to 68 C.Y. of spoils. Once the grading is complete the area will be top dressed with 12 C.Y. of Pulverized topsoil and graded. The soil will be seeded and fertilized. 400 S.F. of Single Sided Erosion control blanket will be rolled out and stapled to the soil to provide the ditch area with turf restoration. Clean up of all debris and soils generated during this project will be completed at the end of the project.


