**ORDINANCE 15-049**

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**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING CERTAIN PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS  
IN THE GOODINGS GROVE, PHASE 2 SUBDIVISION**

**WHEREAS**, the developer (Gallagher & Henry) has completed certain public improvements in Goodings Grove, Phase 2; and

**WHEREAS**, the above mentioned public improvements include the final surface and curb & gutter repairs on Greystone Drive, from the south terminous point, as indicated in the Goodings Grove, Phase 2 subdivision plat, to just north of the intersection of Greystone Drive at Glengary Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, the above mentioned public improvements have been inspected by Village and Homer Township Highway Department staff and have been found to be constructed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities have determined it to be in the best interest of the Village to accept Greystone Drive (back of curb to back of curb only), from the south terminous point, as indicated in the Goodings Grove, Phase 2 subdivision plat, to just north of the intersection of Greystone Drive at Glengary Drive; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homer Glen, Will County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: The Village hereby accepts Greystone Drive (back of curb to back of curb only), from the south terminous point, as indicated in the Goodings Grove, Phase 2 subdivision plat, to just north of the intersection of Greystone Drive at Glengary Drive.

Section 2: Severability – The invalidity of any section, part, provision, term or phrase of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof.


Section 3: Conflicts – All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of any such conflict or inconsistency.

Section 4: Effective Date - This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
