Will County Bond Issuance

On March 17, Will County Board members voted to authorize up to \$275 million in bonds to pay for a new courthouse, a sheriff's facility, and a health department. You have the option to weigh in on whether the County should borrow the money. A public hearing about the bonds is scheduled at 9:30 am on April 21 at the Will County office building, 302 N. Chicago St., Joliet. You also have the opportunity to file a petition with the Will County Clerk to put the bond issue on the November 8 ballot.

The Village has notified its Landlord and Property Manager of its "Intent to Terminate the Lease Agreement" at its current location by July 31, 2016.





