NEW OPTIONS FOR ELECTRONIC RECYCLING IN WILL COUNTY

Will County recently opened two new electronic dropoff locations near the Homer Glen community. New Lenox Township, located at 1100 S. Cedar Road in New Lenox is open the second and fourth Wednesday of the month from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. Romeoville Public Works, located at 615 Anderson Drive in Romeoville is open the first and third Tuesday of the month from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. The Lockport Public Works, located at 17112 Prime Blvd. continues to operate every Tuesday and Friday from 6 a.m. to 11 a.m. There is a limit of two televisions per vehicle. All centers are open to Will County residents (proof of residency required).

MISCELLANEOUS PARK IMPROVEMENTS

The Village's Facilities Maintenance crew has been hard at work sprucing up several of the Village's parks. Kingston Hills received 24 yards of mulch, the playground area was weeded, and several of the planting beds were cleaned up. Stonebridge Park received two new toddler swings that replaced two dilapidated swings.



2016 ROAD RESURFACING PROGRAM

The Homer Glen Village Board recently approved the 2016 Road Resurfacing Program. Streets selected for resurfacing were based on inspections performed by the Homer Township Road District and Village of Homer Glen staff.

Forest View Drive from Lake View Drive to Will Cook Road (3,030 feet), Lake View Drive from Lake View Court to Will Cook Road (2,550 feet), Woolly Hill Drive from Forest View Drive to Lake View Drive (930 feet), Woolly Hill Court from Woolly Hill Drive to East End (390 feet), Murvey Drive from Forest View Drive to Woolly Hill Drive (920 feet), Murvey Court from South End to Murvey Drive (390 feet), Hiawatha Court (200 feet), Teakwood Drive (2,200 feet), Split Rail Drive (200 feet), Lemont Road from Nolan Court to Janas Parkway (4,630 feet), Janas Drive from West End to Lemont Road (650 feet), Cokes Road (90 feet), Shady Lane from Gougar Road to East End (675 feet), Forest Court from Shady Lane to North End (120 feet), 167th Street from Eastlake Parkway to Parker Road (7,075 feet), Parker Road from 163rd Street to Dokter Place (1,125 feet) and Oak Court from West End to Oak Trail (326 feet). MOSQUITO ABATEMENT

The third community-wide mosquito spraying took place on Tuesday August 2.

Residents can receive advanced notice of spray events by contacting Clarke directly and signing up through their Mosquito Hotline at 1-(800) – 942 - 2555 and asking to be added to the, "Prior Notification List," for the Village of Homer Glen. Residents will be asked to provide their name, address, and phone number, and this will allow them to receive a phone call from Clarke the day of the Village-wide spray.

Larvacide control and treatment in drainage and detention basins is recurring throughout the summer months in addition to the four monthly community-wide sprayings scheduled between June - September.

The fourth and final community wide spraying of the season is tentatively scheduled to occur before the Labor Day Holiday on September 5.
