




- DEVELOPED TO ACCOMMODATE APPROXIMATELY 2 ACRES OF OPEN LAND
- NEEDS STRUCTURED SURFACE TO ALLOW SET UP OF EQUIPMENT AND CARNIVAL
- PROVIDE GOOD DRAINAGE
- ALLOW FOR USE BY ATHLETIC GROUPS TO SET UP AND ORGANIZE PRACTICE AREAS



Festival Grounds/Athletic Fields






- CENTRALIZED OUTDOOR FITNESS STATIONS TO CREATE A MULTI-DISCIPLINE WORKOUT AREA
- FULL RANGE OF EXERCISE EQUIPMENT THAT PROMOTE AEROBIC, MUSCLE STRENGTH, CORE STRENGTH, AND BALANCE AND FLEXIBILITY
- RESILIENT SURFACING AS REQUIRED
- OPEN TO PUBLIC USE

- NATURE INSPIRED THEME BASED PLAY AREAS INCORPORATING A VARIETY OF LANDSCAPE FEATURES AND OBJECTS TO HELP CHILDREN DEVELOP PHYSICAL FITNESS AND STRENGTH AS WELL AS BALANCE AND COORDINATION SKILLS
- DEDICATED PLAY SPACE FOR CHILDREN TO RUN AND PLAY
- PLAY EQUIPMENT MADE FROM NATURAL AND PREFABRICATED MATERIALS WHICH ARE MOVABLE AND CAN BE MANIPULATED

- DEVELOP A LONG RANGE MASTER PLAN APPROACH TO RESTORING PORTIONS OF THE LAND TO MANAGE STORMWATER
- PROMOTE THE USE OF NATIVE SPECIES
- PROVIDE DIVERSITY IN PLANT TYPES
- PROVIDED EDUCATIONAL INTERPRETATION



Restoration






- INTIMATE SPACES WHERE YOUNG CHILDREN CAN BE IMMERSSED IN THE SCENTS, TEXTURES, AND COLORS OF PLANTS AND RELATED ELEMENTS
- INCLUDE PLANTINGS THAT STIMULATE SENSES – SOUND, TOUCH, SMELL, SIGHT, AND TASTE
- PROVIDE A GARDEN EXPERIENCE FOR MULTI-GENERATIONAL USERS AS WELL AS SPECIAL NEEDS
- DEVELOP A GARDEN LEARNING EXPERIENCE
- SENSORY AND CONTEMPLATIVE SPACE FOR MEDITATION

- DEVELOP CONNECTED LOOPS AND CIRCUITS FOR WALKING AND JOGGING
- LOOK AT LOGICAL TRAIL CONNECTIONS FOR THE COMMUNITY
- PROVIDE PAVED PATH SYSTEM
- PROVIDE SEATING AND RESPITES ALONG TRAIL EXPERIENCE
- CONSIDER EMERGENCY CALL LOCATIONS FOR TRAIL USERS

- MAINTAINED COMMUNITY SPACE DESIGNED TO COMPLEMENT THE NEW VILLAGE HALL
- LAWN SPACE WITH DEMONSTRATION ORNAMENTAL PLANTINGS
- OPEN LAWN AREA FOR FESTIVALS, INFORMAL PERFORMANCES, AND SMALL EVENTS
- BRICK PAVED/DECORATIVE CONCRETE COURT YARD AND WALKWAYS INCLUDING A KIOSK, BENCH SEATING AND BIKE RACKS
- DEDICATED MEMORIAL SPACE WITH COMMEMORATIVE WALL/MONUMENT FEATURE TO HONOR LOCAL SERVICE MEN AND WOMEN



Village Green



- OPEN SPACE TO ALLOW FOR WINTER ACTIVITIES AND POSSIBLE FESTIVAL EVENTS
- TAKE ADVANTAGE OF EXISTING VEGETATION AND TERRAIN TO PROVIDE WINTER INTEREST AND PLAY
