National Public Lands Day and Designating  
September 28, 2013 as Homer Glen Lands Day**

**Whereas**, since 1994, the National Education and Training Foundation in Washington D.C. has organized and sponsored National Public Lands Day as a show of support for recognizing and protecting significant areas in the natural environment; and

**Whereas**, September 28<sup>th</sup> has been designated as National Public Lands Day for the year 2013; and

**Whereas**, the Village of Homer Glen was founded and incorporated in large part due to the desires of its citizens to preserve the unique and diverse components of the natural environment within the Village; and




