AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RELOCATION OF A TRAFFIC CONTROL
DEVICE (NO PARKING SIGN)

WHEREAS, the Village of Homer Glen has received a request for the relocation of a no parking sign on Surrey Lane; and

WHEREAS, the application has been reviewed by the Public Services and Safety Committee of the Village of Homer Glen, which has recommended the approval of such request; and

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-208 to regulate the standing or parking of vehicles under its jurisdiction, and has determined that the placement of the no parking sign referenced above is in the best interest of the Village and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HOMER GLEN, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1: Recitals – The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance No. 10-008, as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: Authorization of Placement of a No Parking Sign – A no parking sign is hereby declared to be relocated from the parkway in front of Lot 8 of Michael’s Place Subdivision to the parkway, approximately 10-feet east of the lot line between Lot 3 and Lot 4 of the Michael’s Place Subdivision (See attached Exhibit A).

Section 3: Violation and Penalty – The operator, owner or lessee of any motor vehicle, or any person, firm, corporation or business entity who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$250.00 for each separate offense.

Section 3: Severability - The various portions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly declared to be severable, and the invalidity of any such portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portions of this Ordinance, which shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible.

Section 4: Repealer - All ordinances or portions of ordinances previously passed or adopted by the Village of Homer Glen that conflict with or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5: Effective Date - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.


