**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING AND AUTHORIZING THE
PLACEMENT OF NO PARKING SIGNS ON PORTIONS OF ARBORETUM DRIVE &
SWEETWATER DRIVE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Homer Glen, Will County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the “Home Rule Powers”); and

WHEREAS, the Village of Homer Glen has received a request for the placement of no parking signs on Arboretum Drive, and Sweetwater Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Village has received a request to prohibit parking and authorizing placement of no parking signs on portion of Arboretum Drive and Sweetwater Drive application has been reviewed by the Public Services and Safety Committee of the Village of Homer Glen, which has recommended the approval of such request; and

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-208 to regulate the standing or parking of vehicles under its jurisdiction, and has determined that the placement of the no parking sign referenced above is in the best interest of the Village and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HOMER GLEN, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, BY AND THROUGH ITS HOME RULE POWERS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Incorporation of Recitals - The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof the same as if they were set forth verbatim herein.

Section 2: Definition - The word “Park” shall mean the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than when temporarily and actually engaged in loading or unloading of merchandise, property, or passengers, and except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic, or in compliance with the direction of a police officer or traffic control signal or device.

Section 3: Prohibition of Parking – It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to park the vehicle on those portions of the following streets, within the Village of Homer Glen, as hereinafter designated:

- i. on the South side of W. Sweetwater Drive between Parker Road on the East and S. Arboretum Drive on the West, and
- ii on the West side of S. Arboretum Drive from W. Sweetwater Drive on the South and Heatherwood Drive on the North.

Section 4: Authorization of Placement of No Parking Signs– Appropriate signs shall be erected informing the public that parking thereon is prohibited as herein above provided.

Section 5: Violation and Penalty- The operator, owner or lessee of any motor vehicle, or any person, firm, corporation or business entity who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$250.00 for each separate offense.

Section 6: Severability - The various portions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly declared to be severable, and the invalidity of any such portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portions of this Ordinance, which shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible.

Section 7: Repealer - All ordinances or portions of ordinances previously passed or adopted by the Village of Homer Glen that conflict with or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 8: Effective Date - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
