**A. CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order on April 12, 2023 by Mayor Yukich at 7:02 p.m. in the Village Board Room, 14240 W. 151<sup>st</sup> Street, Homer Glen.

Attorney Eric Hanson stated that they do not have a quorum to continue with the regular meeting, but they still can proceed with the public hearing for the budget.

**PUBLIC HEARING - Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024**

Mayor Yukich stated the following:



Trustee Pazmino stated for the record that the reason for there not being a quorum was a few of the Trustees thought they would be able to call in for the meeting, but did not realize the COVID-19 emergency order had been retracted and remote meetings are no longer allowed.
