

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SEWER AND WATER TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, the provision of potable water and sanitary sewer service within the Village of Homer Glen is a matter of great complexity and great concern to the Village and its citizens

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Village to create a Task Force comprised of persons with the appropriate expertise, skills and interest to fully investigate the provisions of potable water and sanitary sewer service within the Village of Homer Glen and to make recommendations with respect thereto to the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HOMER GLEN, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1: Recitals – The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance No. 04-031 as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: Establishment of Sewer and Water Task Force – The first sentence of Section 2 of Ordinance No. 04-003 of the Village of Homer Glen is hereby amended to include the establishment of the Sewer and Water Task Force. The operation and activities of the Sewer and Water Task Force shall in all respects be subject to Ordinance No. 04-003.

Section 3: Duration – The Sewer and Water Task Force shall complete the performance of its duties on or before that date which is 6 months from the date of the adoption of this Ordinance, unless the Village President shall direct such Task Force to continue in existence for some other longer period of time.

Section 4: Severability - The various portions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly declared to be severable, and the invalidity of any such portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portions of this Ordinance, which shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible.


Section 5: Repealer - All ordinances or portions of ordinances previously passed or adopted by the Village of Homer Glen that conflict with or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 6: Effective Date - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
