

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AMENDMENTS TO THE MUNICIPAL CODE AND
THE PUBLIC UTILITY ACT RELATING TO WATER AND SANITARY SEWER
SERVICE AS PROPOSED IN HOUSE BILL 4333 INTRODUCED BY
REPRESENTATIVE RENEE KOSEL

WHEREAS, the Village of Homer Glen and its residents have experienced and continue to experience a number of issues relating to the provision of water and sanitary sewer service from the utility provider of such services in the Village of Homer Glen; and

WHEREAS, Representative Renee Kosel has on December 29, 2005, introduced in the 94th General Assembly of the State of Illinois House Bill 4333 which provides for amendments to the Municipal Code and the Public Utility Act to create certain restrictions and requirements upon utility providers of water and sanitary sewer service to help insure that utility customers are receive an appropriate quality of utility service and that the charges and billing for such services are fair and reasonable;

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Homer Glen believes that the implementation of the amendments proposed in House Bill 4333 would address a number of the issues which currently exist relating to the provision of water and sanitary sewer service and that it would be in the best interests of the Village of Homer Glen and its residents to support the adoption of House Bill 4333.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HOMER GLEN, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

Section 1: Recitals – The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: Statement of Support – The Corporate Authorities of the Village of Homer hereby support the adoption of House Bill 4333 introduced in the 94th General Assembly of the State of Illinois by Representative Renee Kosel.

Section 3: Severability- The various portions of this resolution are hereby expressly declared to be severable, and the invalidity of any such portion of this resolution shall not affect the validity of any other portions of this resolution, which shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible.

Section 4: Repealer- All ordinances or portions of resolutions previously passed or adopted by the Village of Homer Glen that conflict with or are inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5: Effective Date- This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
