AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ADDITION OF PARKER ROAD (CH 1) FROM THE NEW LENOX-HOMER TOWNSHIP LINE NORTHERLY 1.04 MILES TO NORTH EDGE OF PAVEMENT OF CHICAGO BLOOMINGTON TRAIL/HADLEY ROAD, IN ITS ENTIRETY, AND CHICAGO BLOOMINGTON TRAIL/HADLEY ROAD FROM THE WEST EDGE OF PAVEMENT OF PARKER ROAD EASTERLY AND NORTHEASTERLY 2.10 MILES TO THE WILL-COOK COUNTY LINE, IN ITS ENTIRETY, A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 3.14 MILES, TO THE VILLAGE STREET SYSTEM OF THE VILLAGE OF HOMER GLEN, COOK AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Homer Glen, Will County, Illinois (the "Village") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the "Home Rule Powers"), including passing resolutions in support of protecting historic routes; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Homer Glen Board of Trustees passed Resolution 23-013, on September 13, 2023, supporting the protection of the "Heritage Routes" of Parker Road, Hadley Road and Chicago-Bloomington Trail in Homer Glen, Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Homer Glen Board of Trustees have determined that the best course of action to protect this roadway corridor is through a Jurisdictional Transfer; and,

WHEREAS, the property that is the subject of the Jurisdictional Transfer and of this Ordinance ("Subject Property") is described in the Ordinance and graphically represented in "Exhibit A and Exhibit B"; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Homer Glen agrees to accept, from Will County, the jurisdictional transfer of Parker Road/Chicago Bloomington Trail/Hadley Road (CH 1), to the Village of Homer Glen Street System, hereinafter referred to interchangeably as the "Village Street System"

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Village President and Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Homer Glen, Will County, Illinois, by and through its Home Rule Powers, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That Parker Road (CH 1) from the New Lenox-Homer township line northerly 1.04 miles to north edge of pavement of Chicago Bloomington Trail/Hadley Road, in its entirety, and Chicago Bloomington Trail/Hadley Road from the west edge of pavement of Parker Road

easterly and northeasterly 2.10 miles to the Will-Cook county line, in its entirety, a distance of approximately 3.14 miles, be added to the Village Street System.

Section 3. The various portions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly declared to be severable, and the invalidity of any such portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portions of this Ordinance which shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible.

Section 4. All policies, ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.

Section 6. That the Village Clerk is further authorized and directed to forward a copy of this Ordinance to the Will County Division of Transportation as notification of the passage and approval of this Ordinance.

Section 7. The Village President or Village Manager is hereby authorized to execute any further documents, subject to the approval of the Village Attorney, to finalize and complete the jurisdictional transfer set forth herein.
